MOBILE VOTING - BOTH TYPES

ELIGIBILITY

If you are registered to vote, and located in the Cayman Islands but you are unable to physically attend the polls on polling day, you may apply for **Mobile Voting** using **Form C**.

MOBILE VOTING METHODS

- #1 Elections Office polling staff will visit you in person,
- OR**
- #2 You will be able to vote before polling day at an early voting station.

STEP 2 – MOBILE VOTING PROCESS

MOBILE VOTING PROCESS

In cases where the Registering Officer approves an application for mobile voting, Elections Office mobile teams will visit the registered mobile voter during the weeks before the Election Day to allow the individual **to vote at their requested location** within the Cayman Islands.

The Elections Office mobile voting teams will consist of the following persons: presiding officer, poll clerk, logistic officers, police officer and appointed observers.

IMPORTANT NOTICES:

1. As a 'registered' absent elector at this election you cannot vote at the polling station on Election Day.
2. **FORM-C** shall be completed by the applicant and signed by that elector in the presence of a witness, who must then also sign the form and write in that person's (the witness) full name in the spaces provided
